## What's New in this Release

#### Portal updated to support PHP 7.4<sup>(\*)</sup>

We have updated the Xinet Portal to support PHP 7.4, which will enable far better customization of the Portal pages as well as get Xinet Portal up to a more modern framework which eliminates concerns related to security vulnerabilities.

#### Server updated to support Samba 4.10

The Samba Virtual File System is an incremental part of Xinet Server, as it is heavily used in workflows specific to production cycles, such as design teams or video editing teams. We've made a first step in updating to the highest supported version for the latest release of CentOS/Red Hat 7 operating system.

#### Xinet is now fully compatible with CentOS/RHEL 7

We've updated Xinet to be fully compliant with CentOS/RHEL 7, which means it can be configured and installed on all versions of the OS, **up to 7.8**. This in turn opens up the opportunity for Xinet to work with more modern libraries, such as the aforementioned Samba 4.10.
